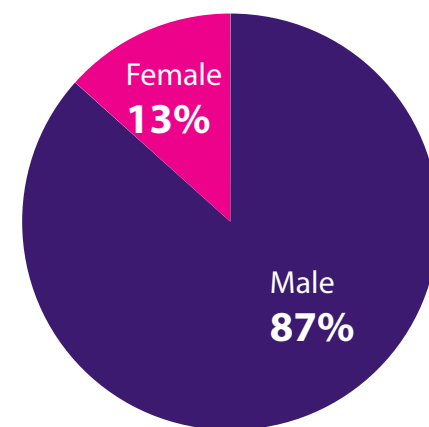
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METHODOLOGY

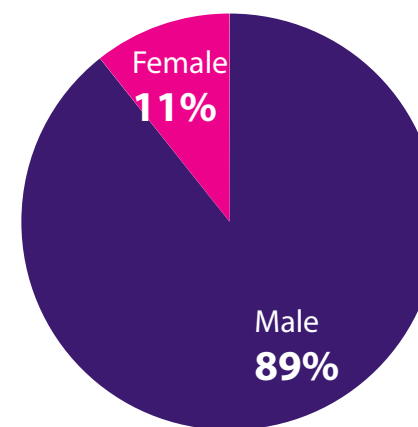
- Major national dailies and online news portals are selected on the basis of their wider circulation and strong public reach.
- Eight main news and two opinion articles from each national dailies and five main news from online news portals are picked for the monitoring
- News portals are scanned for their bylines, news sources, news categories and portrayal of women.
- Data obtained are then analyzed using MS-Excel.

2016: Kantipur, The Himalayan Times, Annapurna Post, Commander Post and Republica monitored from October to December

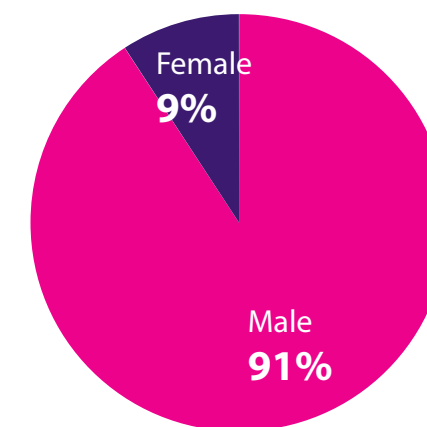


GENDER IN NEWS SOURCES

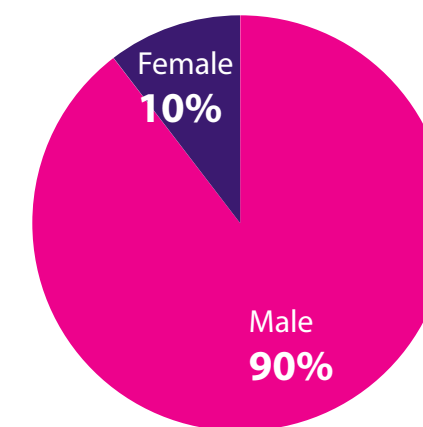

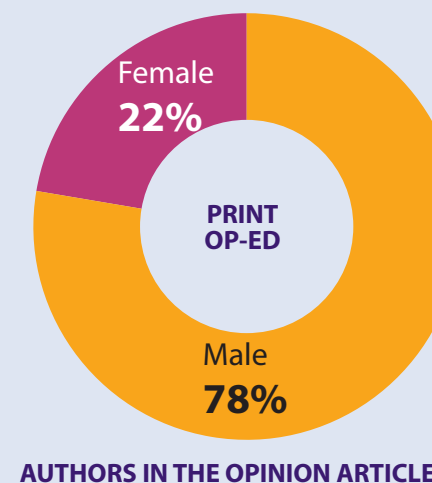
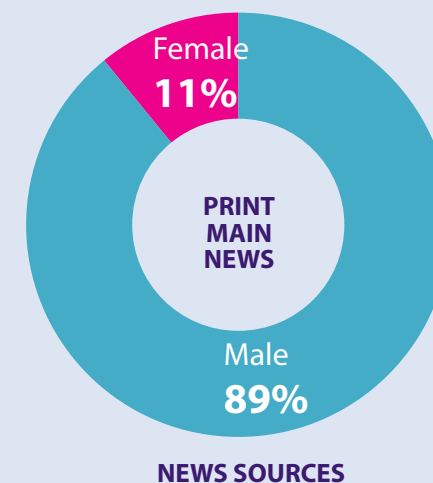
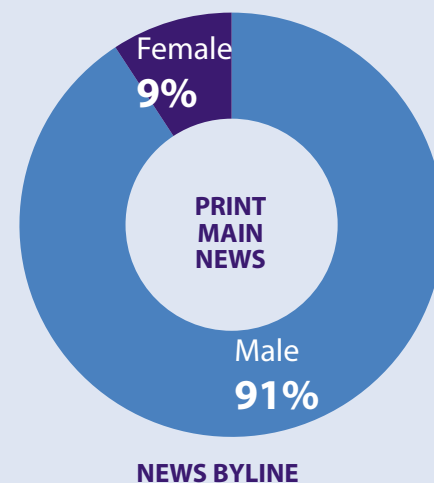
GENDER IN NEWS SOURCES

RECOMMENDATIONS:

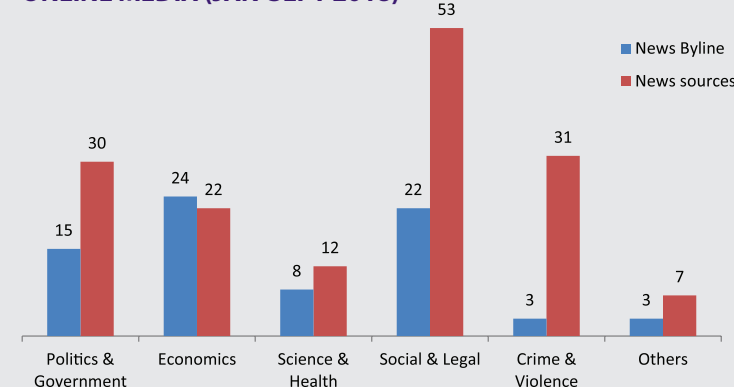
Media houses

- Reform in the editorial and managerial level in media seems imperative to increase women's participation in media
- The media houses need to formulate gender policy and implement strictly to ensure more number of women in their respective media.
- Ensure safety and security of female journalists and create gender friendly working environment

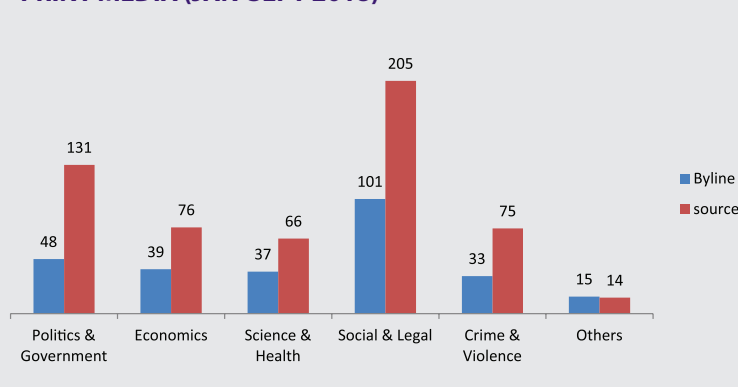
Editors and Chief Reporters

- Promote gender friendly editorial initiatives by assigning female reporters to important beats and increasing their visibility through bylines in the news,
- Direct their reporters to quote possible female sources thus, making gender friendly news contents,
- Ensure at least 30% inclusion of female and marginalized groups as opinion writers/ columnists; this initiative increases their visibility as experts.
- Whether it is male or female news writer writing on any areas as policy, politics, economics, governance, and social maladies as gender discrimination, he/she should make further efforts to seek women as news sources.
- Female participation should be increased both in reporting, and editing desk.
